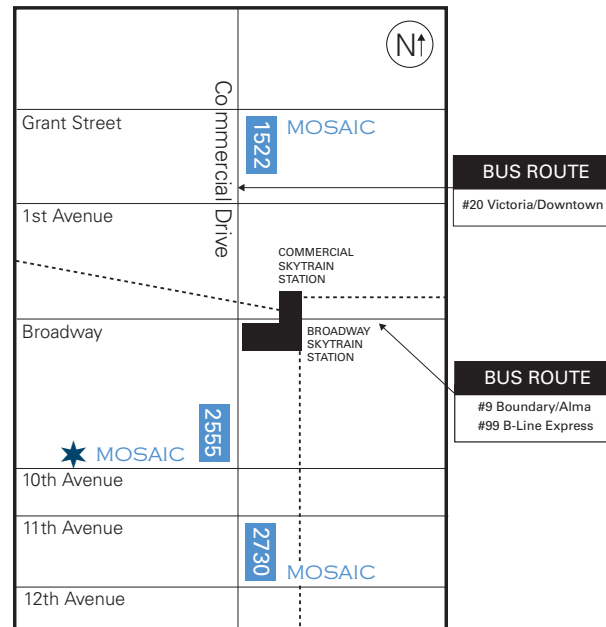
MOSAIC, a Canadian Language Benchmark Placement Test (CLBPT) Licensee, offers the CLBPT Assessment Service for immigrants.

What are the Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB)?

Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) are a national, standardized system of measuring a person's English language proficiency. The Canadian Language Benchmark Placement Test (CLBPT) is a stream-lined, valid test that results in useful information for clients and for those working with them.

CLBPT "scores" can be used to match clients with the appropriate level of training or employment. Gradually, language schools, employment training institutes, colleges and employers are moving towards expressing their program entrance requirements or employee language requirements in terms of CLB levels.

Why should you contact us?

We have been providing the CLBPT service since March 2007. Our assessors all have post-graduate work in adult ESL education, experience working with English language learners, and specific training in administering the CLB. We are a CLBPT licensee.

Testing:

Clients must bring photo ID. Clients arrive for their test as scheduled. Clients show photo identification such as a Permanent Resident Card or BC Driver's License. The CLBPT consists of a speaking and listening test, a writing test, and a reading test – and takes approximately 1½ hours in total.

Results:

Immediately after the test, clients are given their results, e.g. Listening 6, Speaking 7, Reading 6, Writing 8. The test results are also sent or emailed to the counselor within the business day.

When?

Testing takes place Monday and Wednesday afternoons from 1:00pm - 5:00pm, Fridays from 8:30am - 3:00pm and Saturdays from 11:00am - 3:00pm. Additional times may be added depending on demand.
