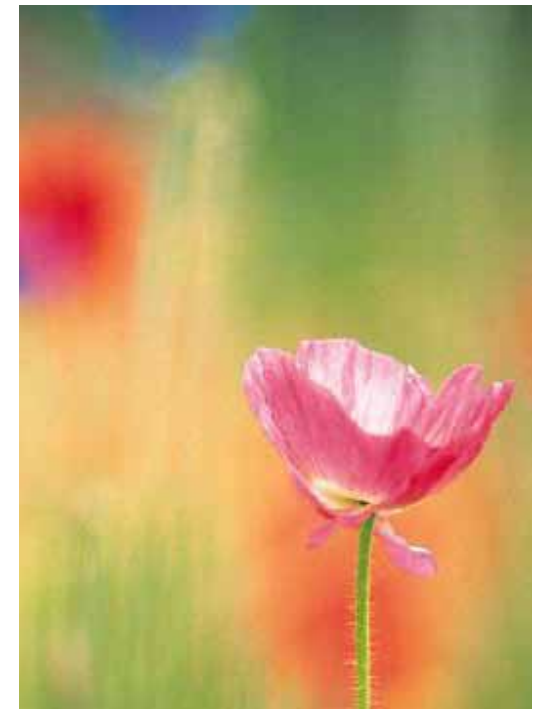

- emotional support
- information, assistance and resources

Enhanced information and support:

- explaining how systems work
- helping to navigate various systems and processes
- information sessions on useful topics
- short-term adjustment counselling

Referrals to places / people that can help:

- referrals to professional services and resources in the community

Service linking:

- helping to complete forms
- helping to make appointments
- speaking to other agencies on clients' behalf
